The Double-Degree Program at a Glance



- The University of Passau is offering a joint double-degree program with the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT), US for Master students
- Participating students can attain two Master degrees:
 - M.Sc. in Business Administration from the University of Passau
 - M.S. in Engineering Management from the NJIT

Structure of program:

- Minimum of 75 ECTS at the University of Passau
- Minimum of 25 ECTS (resp. 15 Credits) at NJIT
- Master's thesis in English language under joint supervision (20 ECTS resp. 6 Credits)
- Available places: 5 students per academic year
- Admission requirements:
 - Enrollment in M. Sc. Business Administration
 - At least 30 ECTS at the time of application and 75 ECTS-Points before the departure to the US
 - Language certificate: at least UNIcert® II or B2 level (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)

NJIT at a Glance

Program Overview



- Degrees from both universities
 - At the University of Passau: M. Sc. Business Administration
 - At NJIT: M. S. Engineering Management
- Program in Passau: 3 semesters, 95 ECTS-Points
 - At least 75 ECTS-Points from lectures
 - 20 ECTS-Points from the Master's thesis
- - 15 Credits from lectures
 - 6 Credits from the Master's thesis (jointly coadviced)
- In addition to the Master Degree from NJIT, graduates can apply for a one-year work permit in the US if they stay for 2 semesters.



- 3 NJIT-Credits for a lecture equal 5 ECTS-Points at the University of Passau
- Regarding the core courses we suggest to transfer 3 courses with each 5 ECTS-Points at the University of Passau with 9 Credits to NJIT
- Students have to complete 5 courses at NJIT, for a total of 15 NJIT-Credits. Those are credited with a total of 25 ECTS-Points in Passau.
- In general, the course selection needs to be coordinated with the program coordinator at the University of Passau.

Admission Requirements





- Enrollment in degree program M.Sc. Business Administration
- Application requirement: At least 30 ECTS-Points
- Admission requirement (i.e. before the departure to the US):
 at least 75 ECTS-Points
- Language certificate (at least UNIcert® II or B2 level)



- Students are expected to meet the language requirements (at least UNIcert® II or B2 level)
- Payment of tuition and fees prior to attendance at NJIT
- Participation in a mandatory health plan offered by the NJIT
- Valid visa (F-1)
- Application at the NJIT

- Curriculum Vitae
- Letter of Motivation
- Current HISQIS record
- Bachelor's diploma
- Two copies of the certificate of enrollment
- Language certificate
- Please hand in required documents until 15th of January directly at the International Office at the University of Passau
- The selection of appropriate candidates is executed by the program coordinator



 After being selected as an appropriate candidate for the double degree program, students need to apply at the NJIT

Student Fees at NJIT



- Tuition and fees: ≈ US \$ 11.000 per semester (full-time student)
- Additional costs:
 - lodging/housing (on-campus to the extent available, or off-campus)
 - food (on-campus meal plans or food allowance);
 - health insurance fees;
 - transportation/airfare;
 - 5) use of refectories and canteens;
 - 6) travel passes, visa costs and passport fees;
 - registration to student unions and other associations;
 - 8) purchase of textbooks and other instructional materials and study aids; and
 - 9) other necessary living/personal expenses.
